Background

FEMA's National Urban Search and Rescue (US&R) Response System (the System) reorganized the advisory structure into a new Advisory Organization found in the System's Administrative Manual Annex A. The working groups were redesigned into four Functional Groups. Under these Functional Groups will be subgroups dealing with specific areas. The Logistical Functions Group has been comprised of three subgroups: Equipment (nine members), Transportation (five members) and Communications (nine members). These Members are considered "subject matter experts" in the field of FEMA US&R Logistics.

- Understanding of an Incident Management Team (IMT).
- Working knowledge of the NIMS framework.

Skills: An aptitude to demonstrate competent performance related with procurement, data inventory/tracking, packaging, movement, and maintenance of cache equipment, facility management.

- Understanding of basic computer programs: Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Visio, and Adobe products.
- Demonstrate and promote the team approach.
- Maintain and write accurate documents, records and reports.

<u>Abilities</u>: Present the resourcefulness and understanding related with present and anticipated objectives tasked with the Logistic Equip Subgroup.

- Respond to all types of communications in a timely manner.
